STATISTICAL TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Throughout my graduate and postdoctoral career, I gained extensive training and experience in the theory and application of various structural equation modeling (SEM) methods. Advanced courses taken as part of my graduate degree covered topics such as Factor Analysis, Multidimensional Scaling, and Longitudinal Research Methods. In addition, I have bolstered my understanding and skills in longitudinal modeling via numerous workshops. Primarily, my research has focused on the use of Path Analysis, Latent Class Analysis, Latent Class

Growth Analysis, and Growth Modeling. I also have experience with Actor-Partner Interdependence Models (APIM), Moderated Mediation models, and Latent Difference Score (LDS) Models. In addition, I use Monte Carlo simulation studies to estimate power analyses for SEM, which has provided statistical support for complex longitudinal design proposals. The results of these efforts include numerous manuscripts and collaborations, as well as multiple grants submitted to and funded from the National Institutes of Mental Health (MH074454, MH093349, MH091363).
